The interest for Art in Bucharest – tours of Bucharest's artists workshops – is growing. Actually, workshops which consist of stimulating creativity and personal development remain one of our strengths.

Our results, based on leadership and on the enthusiastic contribution of our volunteers, represent a very good starting point for the organic grow-up of our activity in 2014. ROI bees count on team-work and partnership and we will continue to do that.



The passing rate for high-school final exam

for 5 technological high-schools included in Zburd-Education through coaching
June - July 2011 - 2013 (overall)



The project Zburd-Education through coaching was implemented in February 2012-June 2013 in 5 technological high-schools from Bucharest, Sibiu, Brasov, Iaşi, Câmpulung Muscel, which had poor results at the high-school final exam (below 20% rate of passing). Also, a significant part of the pupils in such schools come from under-privileged environments. The method can be applied in any school which wants to achieve better performances, but ROI Association aimed that, in the pilot phase, visible results were obtained where they were needed the most.

Throughout a team coaching method, in every high-school a team was formed, which included teachers, pupils, parents and community representatives. This team analized the problems, took responsability, suggested and implemented solutions.


The results were beyond expectations: the passing rate at the final exam was 2-3 times higher in 2013, compared to 2012 (compared to a 22% boost at national level), the absenteeism was substantially reduced and most of the problems regarding violence were resolved. Also, the communication between pupils and teachers improved, as well as the parents involvment in school activities.



This project proves that, when teachers, pupils and parents work together, the results are exceptional, even when most part of the pupils come from under-privileged environments.

The successful stories from the five high-schools are presented in the documentary-film "Ba se poate!" (Yes we can!), directed by Tedy Necula, with the support of the pupils, teachers and parents. The film was made in 2013 and it was launched at the end of the year, with the support of the European Program Youth in Action.

A brief of the film can be watched here: http://youtu.be/Xi0tUnCt6Ug. The purpose of the film is to inspire other schools to implement the method of working in teams composed of teachers, pupils and parents and it was watched in the first 3 months by over 4.000 viewers.







What teachers say:

"We have learned to focus not on the negative aspects, but on what we do to make things better."

"I have learned to listen to my co-workers and to my pupils."

"We have learned to create a place where pupils feel good, a place where they do not come with fear."

What headmasters say:

"I have learned that you can also obtain good things from the disadvantaged pupils."

"The real closeness to the pupils helps them overcome difficulties in learning and catch up with what they do not know, in an easier way."

"The pupils are motivated when you ask for their support, when they feel useful."

" I have collaborated more often with mass-media, thus improving the school's image."

What pupils say:

"I understood that there are extrodinary teachers in this high-school."

"As soon as you enter the school gate, you can see people smiling."

" It is extraodinary that your teacher is your friend as well."

"In order to solve a problem, you must first realize it exists."



What parents say:

- "I understood that the teacher is a partner."
- "The teacher is a vector, first of all, he creates characters."
- "The kids do not see what they learn at school as a subject, they see what there is in the human being in front of them".
- "My child feels safe and he goes to school with pleasure. He does not want to move in antother high-school any more."
- "I have a better relationship with my child and he now respects his teachers more."





Together with Scoala de Valori (School of Values), ROI Association initiated in 2013 the project "Adopt a high-school". This way, we are starting an innovative program. Its purpose is to intervene in an integrative way, on a medium term, in several technological high-schools from the country, starting 2014.

After 3 years of intervention, "Adopt a high-school" wants the high-schools that benefit from the program to become centers of excellence, which form other schools that want to obtain better performances in the region.

The initiative responds to issues such as:

the gap between schools and the labor market; the lack of motivation and the low self-esteem;

the lack of collaboration between teachers-pupils-parents and community; the need to improve the educational process and the access to education; encouraging initiative in schools.



Over 20 high-schools have applied, at the end of 2013, in order to be included in the project.

The high-school representatives took part, between 22-24 November, in a workshop organized in Păltinis, with the support of the Ministry of National Education and the Ministry of Youth and Sport.

The selection of a certain high-school depends on the openness of its management and on the resources available, as well as on the support of the local authorities and of the local business environment.

meant to the well-being of the participants through various activities, such as floral


design, painting, guidance and coaching sessions.

This kind of workshops were organized both for the public and for the employers of companies. The team that was involved in the


